

Town of New Marlborough
Board of Health Meeting
March 12, 2013

The meeting began at 7PM with Chairman Larry Davis, III, Jack Bellinger, and Scott McFarland present. Norm Hankey was absent.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted.

Title 5: 139 Clayton-Mill River Rd. showed a last inspection in 2005. At that time the plans showed a one bedroom house. The house has undergone extensive renovations and expansion, showing 5 bedrooms. There was a laundry well out front which has consequently been built over. A small tank, out back, with 2 twenty foot trenches are currently servicing the septic effluent. The Board states that a 2,000 gallon tank must be installed with further evaluation to be done.

Transfer Station: A discussion on the forms for permitting a waste station were discussed. Scott will work with Mike Skorput and Alvin Stalker as to filling in the details required.

Southfield Store: Scott and Bob Tynan will meet to inspect the new system on Tuesday the 19th.

Pumping reports: Two were submitted.

Mail: Mill River Water Takers, Southfield Water Co. and Gedney Farm all were sent non-compliance notices from the DEP. These matters will be handled by the State and those concerned.
