Monthly meeting Feb. 10th, 2015

The meeting began at 7PM with Larry Davis, III, Chairman, Jack Bellinger, Member, Norman Hankey, Member and Scott McFarland, Agent present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were corrected at the 4th paragraph to read “tight tank design was discussed” instead of “approved”. Minutes accepted as corrected.

Mike Parsons of Kelly, Granger & Parsons, was present to discuss the plans for 28 Downs Rd. on Lake Buel. A tight tank was proposed by the design Mike submitted. There followed a lengthy discussion exploring other options since the property is one of three parcels owned by related family members. This property could not support a full septic system, therefore a tight tank is being considered. Mike will talk with the related people to see if another option could be explored. He will let the Board know.

At 89 Lakeside a PercRite system SK Design for a tight tank was proposed. The owner does not want to build a leach field. Should there be a leach field available in the future at the sale of the house, the TT could be retro fitted to discharge to the leach field. A Monolithic 2000 gallon tank designed for 3 bedrooms is what Scott suggested.

At 28 East Hill Rd., Courtney & Donna Turner had a failed system and an upgrade was for a new system was installed by Shane Oates.

There was no update to Camp Segowea.

Mail and pumping reports were reviewed.
