April 14, 2015
Monthly Meeting

The meeting began at 7 PM with Larry Davis, III, Chairman, Jack Bellinger, Member, and Scott McFarland, Agent present. Noman Hankey was absent.

Present to discuss the Mill River Farm was the owner, Jan Johnson. The topic was concerning the operation of a poultry processing unit at the farm. Ms Johnson has passed tests by the state in reference to this process. She is allowed to process a maximum of her own raised 50 birds per week. Chickens are penned in sanitary conditions and are moved daily to new grassy areas. All refuse is to be handled under strict guidelines. The center of the compost pile will contain the innards and feathers. Any water used in the process, ie; bloody water is captured. The birds will be processed outside.

There are no Federal Regulations concerning a Small Farms operation. BOH has no interest in the process re: licensing.

Scott will be looking to see if a public hearing is required on this matter.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and corrections have been made. "the property at 28 Downs Rd. will have a new tight tank, the tank at 35 Downs Rd. will be sealed making it a tight tank."

At 62 Hadsell Rd. having two houses must be connected: accepted as amended.
Upgrade: 89 Lakeside Rd. : 2000 gallon tight tank for seasonal use.

105 Knight Rd.. has a failed system. Palfini is selling. Parsons has a redesigned system.

150 Cross to Canaan Valley, Killeen, has passed.

WaWa Segowea: Operating for the 2015 season with 88 overnight campers and 50 day campers. The current well is sufficient for current occupancy. A new well must be made if expanding occupancy. Septic to be connected to the larger system.

The camp has been licensed for this year with the above conditions.

Alliance meeting bidding for coverage by the VNA. VNA and Mavin to work together.

A review of fees will be discussed at the next meeting.
