

Board of Health
July 14, 2015 Monthly meeting

The meeting began at 7:05 with all members present, Larry Davis, III, Chairman, Norm Hanky, and Jack Bellinger, Members, and Scott McFarland, Agent.

The office has been moved upstairs to the former Tax Collector's office.

Minutes of the previous meet were wpproved.

It was noted that a "Wired West" "tasting" fund raiser was being held at the new Cantena 229 which has an approval for 6 "Taco Tuesdays". Scott noted that the seating is for 25 and the septic system is capable of handling that load. However, the water must be tested.

WaWaSegowea: The beach water at "Harmon Pond" was slightly contaminated.

At 909 Norfolk Rd.: The house was gutted having not been kept up by the former owner. A front house wants a tie in to the system, but must have a Title Five done since the system is close to the water supply.

DEP the Public Water Sanitary Survey surveys every several years and found Mill River Water Takers which has two springs are not in compliance. A water line is broken. Water from Spring#1 not getting to the well house. The DEP should notify BOH when things break.

Peerless Tree Co. There is no evidence of a well permit. Tom Carmody issued a building permit which did not reach the BOH office. Scott is to find out from Tom why there is no paperwork re: building permit or well permit and possibly a septic permit since an office maybe placed in the propose building.

Scott is seeking a grant for a new computer.
