Meeting began at 7:10 PM with all members present.

Minutes of the March meeting was approved with a typo correction.

138 Woodleigh Ave.: The building to be demolished with new construction with a ~~tight tank~~ *fuel system* installation.

55 Pine Rd, Ambos: is seasonal and wants a tight tank. Scott acknowledged that a septic is to be designed with the owners option to use it as a tight tank. Scott will write an approval.

There was a complaint, reported ^{to} by our chairman, of garbage strewn around East Hill coming from containers at the Southfield Store. Mr. Davis verified that it was all cleaned up.

Received a Title 5 for 29 Clayton Mill River Rd. and also one for 1316 Hartsville New Marlborough Rd.

Scott reported on the Alliance meeting he attended last week. Funding for this has tapered off. Sharing services is difficult with the disparate of towns. However the area is being divided into North County, Central and South counties with Gt. Barrington being the "hub". Towns are talking of sharing offices such as treasurer, tax collector, etc.,

The spring dinner of April 27th will discuss the current topic of opioids. One of the problems being straight heroin.

On Line Permitting is progressing with financing discussed (setup fees, etc.)

VNA contract was reviewed for next fiscal year.
