Meeting

Meeting began at 7:10 PM with all members present.

Minutes were read and corrected to read "full system" in stead of "Tight Tank" at 138 Woodleigh Rd. and the complaint was reported "to" not "by"the Selectmen.

166 East Hill Rd. had a failed system. The house is under new construction. A new design was approved for 6 bedrooms with a 2,000 gallon tank.

7 and 14 Lawrence Lane has a design submitted but not yet approved. There are well issues a shared well perhaps. Lots are close together in that area and septic and well separations are the issues.

Scott is working on the "on-Line" permitting issues with Full Circle and Tara.

Camp WaWaSegowea is applying for a camp permit. The operation is essentially the same as last year.

While Scott issued a food permit to Cantina 229, the issue came up about it not being as yet approved by the State as a Public Water Supplier. DEP will supervise water quality. The process has been started to get DEP on board. The Cantina 229 plans to operate full time in July.

A Food Permit was given to Joan Hobart at 85 New Marlborough-Southfield Rd. to operate a new baking kitchen. Scott inspected the kitchen which is separate from the house was built brand new and found it to be a beautifully designed and executed. She will be using all natural and organic ingredients, working with Tom Brazie to supplying dairy products. Any butchering will be USDA approved. Tom has a refrigerated truck to transport any perishable items.

Septic Pumping reports were read.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15PM.
