Minutes of August 20, 2012

The Meeting was opened at 6:30 PM.

Members present were Chairman Larry Davis & Select Woman Tara White.

The meeting minutes of the previous meeting were waived unto the next meeting.

Mr. Tim Newman, Technology Committee member appeared before the Board requesting the distribution of two items when real estate taxes are mailed. The Board has accepted this request unless the additional items increase postage.

The Board received a letter of recommendation from the Cultural Council to appoint Mrs. Patricia Killeen. Mrs. Killeen also submitted a letter of interest for the appointed position. A motion was made, seconded and so voted to appoint Patricia Killeen to the Cultural Council for the term ending June, 2014.

The Board reviewed and discussed the email agreement with Virtual Town Hall for set up of emails for Town employees.

The Board reviewed and discussed the one bid received for the painting of the Town Hall. The bid was submitted from Northeastern Commercial Services in the amount of \$23,700.00. After discussion a motion was made, seconded and so voted to accept the bid from Northeastern Commercial Services.

The Board informed the public that they attended a work meeting at the Highway Department with engineers for bridge repairs. It was noted that another meeting will be scheduled to review paperwork that needs to be submitted to Mass Works.

The Board stated that Mass Dot has inspected another 4 bridges in Town and there are concerns with each of them

Mr. Fromm and several residents of Lakeside Road appeared before the Board regarding the status of Lakeside Road. Mr. Fromm submitted an informative letter stating the road is a Town road not a private road. The Board has received the information and is still doing research. Mr. Fromm mentioned the portion of road from the mailboxes to Henegan's (old Gibson Grove) residence is a

Town Road not private. The Board will have the Highway Superintendent measure and the Board will contact Mr. Fromm with it's findings.

Being that there was no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded and so voted to adjourn at 7:00 PM.
