

Conservation Commission – November 17, 2012

Members present were co-chair Mr. Ned Wilson & Mr. Peter Marks.

Meeting was called to order at 10:02AM.

Minutes of October 13th were approved as amended.

Weldon Hearing: Present for hearing was Mr. Brian Jefferies, Contractor. Applicant submitted a RDA for the purpose of tearing down the 14ft x 20 ft garage attached to the rear of the main house, also removing asphalt floor and removing debris from site, placing 4 piers approximately 7 feet from the rear of the house at 112ft and 102 ft from the river, but within the original foot print of the garage. The existing stairs will be repaired/built and attached to these piers. Property location is 15 Mill River Great Barrington Road. The commission and Mr. Jefferies review DEP's comments. After discussion a motion was made, seconded to close this hearing. A motion was made, seconded and so voted to approve this hearing as a negative #2 with no conditions.

New Business:

- a. Emergency certificate for Mark Buxbaum – 142 Brewer Hill Road – signed per request of the Board of Health.
- b. Mr. Wilson mentioned that he had received a call from Mr. Odegaard regard his prior filing of a RDA. Mr. Odegaard questioned if he needs to file another RDA if he is going to installing more than one (1) pier. The commission reviewed the prior filings from Mr. Odegaard and if Mr. Odegaard wants to install more than one (1) pier then yes he'll have to file again.

The commission reviewed the mail:

- b. FY 14 Budget form.
- c. Highland Communities Initiative Booklet.
- d. Lief Thorne-Thomsen – filed order of conditions at Register of Deeds.

No other business was brought before the commission, so voted to adjourn at 10:54 AM.
