

Conservation Commission – December 31, 2011

Members present were co-chair Mr. Ned Wilson, & Mr. Peter Marks; meeting was called to order at 10:10 AM.

Meeting minutes of November 19th were waived.

Shalaby Hearing: Present for this continuing hear was representative, Mr. Tom Coote. Applicant submitted a NOI for the purpose of replacement and repair of two agricultural bridge crossings. Property location is 1093 Clayton Mill River Road. Mr. Coote presented a revised NOI, in which the commission discussed and reviewed. The Commission asked how the bridge would be setting? Mr. Coote stated that footers would be used and that the property owner has decide on using Wilkinson's out of Sheffield as their contractor to do the work. Mr. Coote states that piers will cross along on the wing wall; and the applicant will be purchasing the kit from Berkshire Bridge. The Commission inquired on if wing walls will be used for this project. Mr. Coote states no - footers are not recommended by Berkshire Bridge. The Commission would prefer the Applicant to use wing walls. After discussion a motion was made, seconded to close this hearing. Motion passed. A motion was made, seconded to approve this application with the following special conditions: notify the Commission prior to the start of work, Commission to have access to site during work being done. Motion passed.

Grosheim Hearing: No representative was present for site visit or hearing. A motion was made, seconded to continue this hearing.


