The Friends fundraising letter has raised \$6025 to date.**

The library has received \$465 in donations in memory of Dorothea Burnett.

A Scarecrow making workshop will be held on October 18 at 1 pm. In case of rain, it will be held at the Town Hall.

Debbie related the Halloween Party ideas.

She has finished the State Aid report. Our out of town circulation has increased.

Debbie will apply for a cultural council grant to fund author, April Jones Prince to present a program, How a Picture Book is Made, for the Summer Reading Program. The cost is \$298.

Rosemary McAlister has been out recuperating from surgery. The trustees decided to ask her to get a doctor's approval to return to her full time duties.

Prism has not picked up the lights.

The selectmen increased the value of the library building and its contents for insurance purposes, as we requested.

The library will join the Commonwealth eBook collection at a cost of \$250.

Debbie will submit an article to the 5 Village News explaining the eBook collection resources throughout the state and Boston Public Library. Brian will lead a workshop on the Boston Public Library access in January.
